Applies quilting, decorative sewing and non-traditional techniques, embroidery, batik techniques, felting small objects, spinning beads, composing costume accessories, finishing and decorating textiles, and displaying his/her work.

Aim and objectives	The aim of the programme is to provide students with knowledge of the laws of composition and ornamentation, the basic and auxiliary materials used in the manufacture of accessories, and various decorating techniques, in order to develop the qualities of a knowledgeable consumer. Objectives: - Learn how to make a chosen piece of jewellery, creatively sew and decorate a simple textile accessory. - Learn how to use information technology to collect and compile information and present projects.
